Ride Leaders

Appoint and brief Tail End Charlie (TEC)

Welcome riders and first timers

Confirm objectives, ride safe and have fun

Review corner marking procedures

Outline distances, fuelling stops, etc.

Riders

Arrive early fully fuelled and ready to depart

Ride at your own pace for comfort and safety

Maintain good spacing from rider in front

Do not overtake on left of other riders

Stay alert, advise leader or TEC if leaving early

On freeways and multi-lane roads, maintain well-spaced in staggered formation behind leader.

Sunday Ride To Grass Valley 12th January

With temperature forecast being a relatively cooler day at 29C it was planned to do a run out to the Grass Valley Tavern. Ken was under the impression that it had been closed since Covid but was advised by Brian the it had been renovated and open. A great turn out with 14 plus TedE ready to ride including Chris from the Norther Knights.



Morning tea was at Gidgegannup via O'Brian and Reen Roads, a road we haven't done for a while. A good lot of discussions solving the world's problems then on the road again. Taking Fernie Road and Toodyay Roads to the Goomalling -Toodyay Road to cut across to Grass Vally via Jennacubbine. The ride had been planned to get to the Tavern around 11:30am to beat the afternoon heat but unfortunately the Tavern did not open to 12 noon, so some of the group decided to go on to Northam, some to go home, leaving Rob, Chris, Brian, Marlon and Ken to wait on for lunch. Unfortunately, Brian and Ken had probably the worst steak sandwich ever served by a pub!

Ken took a longer way home via York and the Lakes and apart from steak sandwiches, an enjoyable day.

Sunday Ride to Spencer's Brook 2nd February

After the inevitable getting out of town we made our way via the Woop d' doos, O'Brien Road and Roland Road to Parkerville. From there through Darlington, Glen Forest, Mt Helena and Lesmurdie and it was warming up as we headed into Kalamunda and the Dome for coffee and eats. Along the way I watched TedE closely observe and imitate Ken's procedure on how to turn right safely while stopped at a T junction ... in unison, they looked left, they looked right, they checked left again and their heads turned right again in unison as they swung a smooth right onto the main road and onwards. It was a joy to watch. What a little gem!

After the drinks and food and much chatter on all manner of things, we made our way out to the bikes for the next leg which was lunch at Spencer's Brook Hotel, celebrating 140 years and looking just lovely. It was pretty hot by then ... South Canning Mills road to Brookton highway where the trees and undergrowth are looking very green and happy even though it's into February ...
